

FREEDOM FROM SIN

At Cornerstone Prison Church we recently had the opportunity to witness the baptism of two believers. These men were able to come before their brothers in Christ to share how the gospel has made a difference in their lives. They had the opportunity to dig into some of the basics of Christianity, to wrestle with the parts of the faith that sometimes trip people up. They were able to articulate that faith has made a difference and that they have a completely different outlook on life than they had apart from Christ. It is truly an amazing celebration when those we have journeyed with accept Christ and take that step further to say, not only do I accept him, but I want to publicly celebrate my entrance into his family. This wouldn't be possible unless God worked first, drawing men to himself, taking the effort done in and through the church and applying it to individual hearts. It wouldn't be possible unless the message of Jesus' death and resurrection made people willing to admit their sins left them as good as dead and Jesus' resurrection meant they now have a newness of life.

Romans 6:4-7 says:

"⁴ We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. ⁵ For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his. ⁶ For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin—⁷ because anyone who has died has been set free from sin."

Helping others find freedom from sin and all of its symptoms is a great joy whether your setting is a church classroom, a coffee shop, or a prison chapel. When men come to know in their hearts a freedom that means they have greater freedom than they have ever enjoyed even while they remain incarcerated, it is a great gift of God worthy of celebrating.
